IOMA Iowa State Dart Tournament Rules

——— Player Requirements ———

ALL PLAYERS MUST BE NDA AND IOMA SANCTIONED

All players must be a player in good standing with their League Operator.

Player must have played at least 50% of all games at an Iowa location.

Player must have a minimum of 96 games in no less than 8 different weeks in the last 12 months. Of which must be 24 games of "01" (OI/OO games only) with PPD avg. for "01" events and or 24 games of Cricket with a MPR avg. for cricket events to be eligible.

——— During the Event ———

All players are required to carry positive identification at all times. Opposing singles players or opposing Team Captains, prior to start of match, or any tournament Official at any time during the event may ask for and require proof of identification from any and all entrants.

Match forfeit call procedure: only 1, 5 minute intercom call and then, only 1, 1 minute intercom call. After witch match Forfeit will be called! So please watch your times and Bracket.

——— Payouts ———

In order to receive your payout you must have the following information.

Photo ID — — Pay Out Control Voucher

Teams are required to have all players information listed on the voucher. Missing information may result in the issuing of a 1099 for the total amount won by the person signing for the payout. Any player who receives \$600 or more during the tournament (or for 1 Year) will be issued a 1099 having all team members fill out a W-9 form may eliminate the 1099 being issued. You will be required to provide a Social Security Number if you place and win over \$500 for the tournament.

——— Dates / Event Changes ———

Player Entry Deadline — January 3, 2020 with out late fee
and January 10, 2020 with late fees \$25 each event /No entry after this date!

After January 22— No Player Changes in Singles events

Changes to Doubles & Team Events must be made at least 1 hour prior to event start.

Replacement verified average must be equal to or less than player being replaced.

(\$5 Charge for On Site Changes)
